## 2006 MULTI-CLUB HUNT

On Saturday morning I had to get up at 4:00am and drive to Casa Grande to teach a class. I finished teaching my class at 4:30pm and I decided to spend my last few hours of daylight calling instead of driving. I went to some areas that I had never been before. I did four or five stands. On the last stand I called for 15 minutes when I saw something moving. It was a coyote. He stopped at 50 yards and I shot him with the 10 gauge. I bagged him up and was on my way. I wondered if I could make it to the check-in by 9:00pm. Considering I was near Casa Grande and had to drive to Mayor, I didn't know if I could make it in time. I wasn't exactly sure how to get to Chauncey's Ranch where the check-in was. I drove and drove and made it there with 20 minutes to spare.

In previous years only three clubs participated in this hunt and this year there were four clubs, The Arizona Predator Callers, Phoenix Varmint Callers, Southern Arizona Wildlife Callers, and the Extreme Predator Callers. 

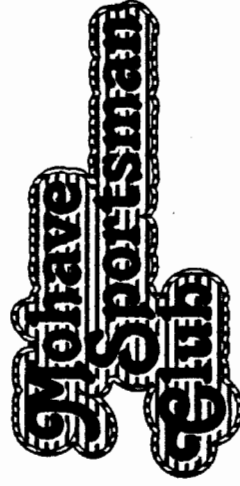

# XVII Annual Antelope Eaters Hunt

March 4-5, 2006  
Seligman, AZ



Sponsored by Mohave Sportsman Club

## Purpose

To reduce coyote population in prime antelope habitat in northern Arizona.

Hunters, we suggest you hunt in game management units:

**7, 8, 9, 10, 18A, 18B, or 19B.**

However, you may hunt in any game management units with antelope hunts.

## Information

The hunt will be conducted over a two-day period, March 4-5, 2006. Drawing for the prizes will be as follows: each team that enters will receive a single red ticket. Half of the total prize money will then be awarded through random drawings of those tickets starting at 9:10 pm Saturday night.

This process will be repeated on Sunday at 2:10 pm with the remaining prize money being dispersed. Remember, Saturday and Sunday drawings are held independent of each other. **Teams must check in each day to be eligible for these cash prizes! Final check-in times are 9 pm Saturday night and 2 pm Sunday in the parking lot of the Black Cat Bar. No coyotes will be accepted after these times!**

The Mohave Sportsman Club reserves the right to deny the privilege of participation in the hunt to any person or team. Any team or person who is cited for any game violation during this hunt will be disqualified! Random coyotes will be temperature checked by tournament officials. Coyotes will be marked by tournament officials with the team number. In the event that any coyotes are determined to have been frozen or taken by autos (i.e., roadkill), that team will be disqualified! Decisions of the tournament officials are final.

## Raffle Prizes

On your initial check-in on Saturday night at the Black Cat Bar, your team will receive 2 blue tickets. These blue tickets will be used for a raffle that will be held on Sunday afternoon, after the cash prizes have been awarded. The blue ticket raffle will include, as first prize, a Savage 16FSS bolt action rifle, with a synthetic stock, 22" stainless steel barrel, accurate trigger, in a non-magnum caliber of your choice. You may purchase additional blue raffle tickets for \$5 each (or 5 for \$20) at the Black Cat Bar until 2 pm, Sunday, March 5, 2006.
