## Mesa Hunter Education Class Announcement Starting Sept. 6, 2011

A Basic Hunter Education class will be held at the Poston Jr. High auditorium (located at 2433 E. Adobe in Mesa) starting Sept 6, 2011 and ending on Oct 1. Classes will be held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:30 to 9:00. There is a 4 hour required field day on Saturday, October 1 at the Rio Salado Sportsman's Club on Usery Pass Road.

In person registration will be held at the first class session (September 6) from 6:30 to 7:00pm. Total cost for the class is \$8.00. Checks should be made out to MHEIA. Please bring your AZ Sportsman/Hunter ID number or Social Security Number to registration. Maximum basic class size is 200 persons.

These classes are for all ages. Parents are encouraged to attend with their youth. This class is required for all persons 10 - 13 years old to hunt big game in Arizona. Students must be at least 9 years old by graduation to be certified. It also qualifies the graduate for a permanent bonus point.
