MORE INFORMATION

This is an Outdoor Skills Mentored Camp. Experienced Mentors in camp will help the Junior Hunters in the field. Arizona Game and Fish Wildlife Managers will be helping to provide areas for the Junior Hunters to go. Mentors will take the time to teach the young hunters how to locate game and share other information and knowledge. Any hunters that harvest an animal will have help back at camp to teach proper skinning and meat care.

There will be a camp briefing for all Junior Hunters, Parents and Mentors on Friday evening. Workshops on calling techniques, glassing, hunting equipment and skinning/fur prep will be held on Friday and Saturday after lunch.

FROM TUCSON

Take Highway 77/Oracle Road to Willow Springs Road. Head North approximately 13 miles to turnoff then turn right and go approximately a mile to the camp. (look for flags and signs)

FROM MESA

Take HWY 60 to Hwy 79 South to Freeman Road. Travel approximately 15 miles to Willow Springs (4 way crossroad) Turn South for approximately 7 miles to camp. (look for flags and signs)

FROM PHOENIX

Take I10 East to HWY 387 WHICH TURNS ONTO hwy 87. At Florence turn Right onto HWY 79. Travel South to Freeman Road and turn East. Travel approximately 15 miles to Willow Springs (4 way crossroad) Turn South for approximately 7 miles to camp. (look for flags and signs)
